5G AND CORONAVIRUS THEORIES

Have you been learning about coronavirus on the internet? If so, you may have come across articles linking 5G to the spread of coronavirus. This is misinformation and completely <u>untrue!</u>

We are going to look into this in detail... so let's go!

So let's get some important facts about 5G clear...

5G - stands for '5th Generation' and refers to the new technological developments in wireless communication (networks), following on from 2G, 3G and 4G

It is a major technological development that will transform how we live our lives. It is not just about having faster internet connection, but about everything being interconnected, including people, objects and machines





What is a Conspiracy Theory?



A conspiracy theory is 'an attempt to explain harmful or tragic events as the result of the actions of a small powerful group'





Conspiracy theories reject the mainstream understanding of an event, often using the mainstream narrative as proof of the conspiracy.

Are they true?



It can be tempting to believe conspiracy theories because they are often exciting and interesting...

BUT

... they are often <u>completely incorrect</u> and usually do not have <u>valid evidence</u> to support them. They may be the result of paranoia and should be treated with **extreme suspicion!**









The 5G Conspiracy



For a long time, conspiracy theories about 5G have existed on the fringes of the internet.

Some people claim it causes serious illnesses including cancer.

REALITY CHECK: this is untrue - the type of radio waves used in 5G networks are 'non-ionising' which means they do not have enough energy to damage DNA and cause damage (leading to cancer)

In fact, the World Health Organisation categorises 5G as less likely to cause cancer than drinking alcohol and eating processed meat!







5G and Coronavirus...



2 main arguments have been used to suggest 5G causes the spread of coronavirus:

- **1)** "5G lowers the human immune system" WRONG, as already mentioned, 5G radiation is much too low to cause damage to the human body
- 2) "the virus communicates using the radio waves so spreads quicker" WRONG, this originally came from the work of a biologist who said bacteria MAY produce electromagnetic signals... this is controversial AND coronavirus is not a bacteria, it is a virus!

ABOVE ALL... coronavirus has spread in countries and cities that don't even have 5G yet!





What's happening?



- In the UK, at least 20 "5G masts" have been destroyed by members of the public who believe the conspiracy theory - they are often not even 5G active...
- Telecoms workers are being attacked and abused at work - they are just making repairs that keep our networks functioning so we can use the internet and call each other
- People are spreading this misinformation about the virus which makes it much harder to fight - if we don't understand what is true, how can we protect ourselves from Covid-19?
