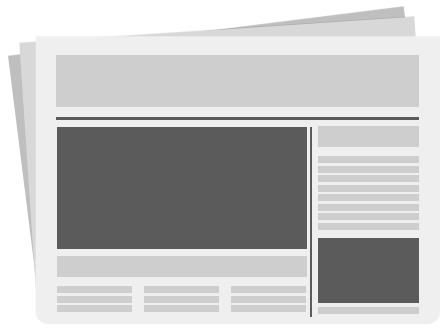




HOW TO SPOT FALSE NEWS



READ BEYOND THE HEADLINE

Headlines can be sensational in an effort to get clicks. Consider what the whole story may be about and why they have chosen that headline.

CONSIDER THE SOURCE

Click away from the story or video to investigate the site, its mission, who owns it and its contact information.



CHECK YOUR BIASES

Check your own biases, consider if your own beliefs could affect your judgement when reading and watching anything online.

INVESTIGATE YOUR SOURCE

Check the author, the byline, the date it was published and the spelling and grammar. What is the agenda?

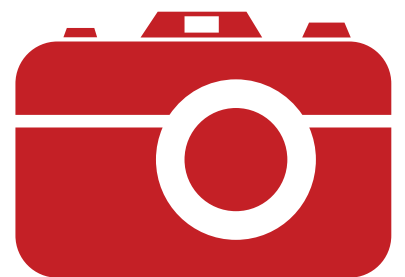


IS IT A JOKE?

If its too outlandish, it might be satire. Research the site and author to be sure.

IS IT AUTHENTIC?

Use google reverse image search before sharing photos to verify their original source. Check mainstream media sites.
